What is Quizlet?

- A website providing learning tools for students to study course material.
- Students can engage with flashcards, spelling practice, vocabulary games, and adaptive activities.

- You can sign up with your Google account

What's so great about Quizlet?

- Gamifies course content
- Easy to include images
- Easy to invite your students
- Students choose how they want to study
- It's available as an app for learning on the go
- Students can personalize content or create their own study resources
- Audio available in 18 different languages – Great for language learners!
- It's free (a paid version with enhanced features is available)

How can I use it in my online, classroom, or hybrid course?

- Create vocabulary study sets to promote engagement with content
- Embed the study sets right into your course in Blackboard for easy access
- Encourage students to create their own student sets

Something to note:

- While you can check student progress with a *paid* teacher account, Quizlet is not designed to create scored activities

How will my students access Quizlet?

- Embed activities directly in Blackboard
- Send students an email invitation through Quizlet
- Email or post a link for students
