## Foundations of Online Teaching



### COURSE DESCRIPTION

This 5-week online course prepares faculty participants for effective online instruction. Participants will learn best practices in online teaching, basic technical skills in using the College’s learning management system (LMS), and division-level policies for online teaching. The course also introduces students to the college’s support resources for online teaching and learning.

### COURSE MATERIALS

All course materials are presented within the course site. Access to a computer and Internet with software compatible with Blackboard Learn and multimedia capability is necessary. A webcam and headphones with a microphone are recommended but not required.
