# Distance Education Enrollments at Illinois Colleges and Universities

Data for Fall 2014

### **Executive Summary**

Illinois colleges and universities reported a total of 323,396 enrollments in online and blended courses during the Fall 2014 term. Enrollments in all distance education courses totaled 329,475 for Fall 2014 term. Online and blended courses reported by all institutions show a 29% growth from Fall 2013 and accounted for 98.15% of all enrollments for Fall 2014.

#### **Online Courses and Enrollments**

Illinois colleges and universities reported **323,396** enrollments during the Fall 2014 term. This is a **29%** increase in enrollments from Fall 2013 when there were **249,883** enrollments.

#### **Blended Courses**

All Illinois institutions now provide data on blended courses. The **40,891** enrollments for Fall 2014 account for **12.41%** of all distance education enrollments. Blended and online enrollments accounted for **98.15%** of all distance education enrollments for Fall 2014.


#### Online Enrollments by Sector

Community colleges account for **27.4%** of all online course enrollments and **28.1%** of all distance education enrollments. The table on page 3 shows online enrollments by sector from Fall 2005 through Fall 2014. **Note:** There is an additional Independent For Profit Institution that has previously not been included.

#### **Enrollments in Online Courses**

This graph shows online course enrollments reported by Illinois colleges and universities for the Fall terms since Fall 1999.

### Changes in Enrollment by Delivery Mode

#### **Online Enrollment Percentage**

Online enrollments accounted for **85.7**% of all distance education enrollments in the Fall 2014 term with blended enrollments accounting for another **12.4**% for a total of **98**% of all enrollments.

#### **All Other Delivery Mode Percentage**

Enrollments in all delivery modes except for Interactive TV decreased for the Fall 2014 term, although only **2.08%** of enrollments were in delivery modes other than online. Table 2 in the Appendix shows the change in distance education enrollments by delivery mode from Fall 2013 through Fall 2014.

## Online Enrollments by Sector

#### **Community College Enrollment**

During the Fall 2014 term, community colleges reported **88,469** enrollments for **27.36%** of all online course enrollments.

#### **Public University Enrollment**

Public universities reported 47,287 enrollments for 14.62% of all online course enrollments.

#### **Independent For-Profit Colleges and Universities**

Independent for-profit colleges and universities reported **157,187** enrollments for **48.61%** of all online course enrollments.

#### **Independent Not-For-Profit Colleges and Universities**

Independent not-for-profit colleges and universities reported **30,453** enrollments for **9.42%** of all online course enrollments.

#### Institutions With the Largest Online(Internet and Blended) Enrollments

The Illinois institutions reporting the largest online course enrollments during the Fall 2014 term in each sector of higher education in Illinois were:


College of DuPage (12,722) and Moraine Valley Community College (4,898) from the community college system.

University of Illinois at Chicago (10,046) and University of Illinois at Springfield (7,462) from the public universities.

DeVry University (111,774) from the independent for-profit colleges and universities.

DePaul University (9,235) from the independent not-for-profit colleges and universities.
